FAQ

Emerging Scholars:

For the purpose of this conference, emerging scholars are defined as researchers who have completed their PhD thesis within the last 3 years. This is the sole qualifying criterion, irrespective of age.

PhD Students:

The conference is not a doctoral workshop. PhD students are welcome to submit only if their work is advanced and they are close to completion.

Co-authored papers:

Co-authored papers are welcome, provided the emerging scholar is the main contributor to the study. To this end, an email confirmation from the supervisor (or senior co-author) will suffice.

It is however a requirement of the conference that the emerging scholar will present the work, if selected.

Special Issue European Journal of Finance:

Papers submitted to the conference need to be unpublished at the time of submission. Authors are required to indicate whether they wish their paper to be considered for the special issue of the European Journal of Finance.
